If the model is too large to fit into the canvas, you can zoom in or out to give the canvas more room to display the entire model. To view the model from all angles, you can move the model around the computer screen with the mouse or use the Trackball Control. Each view shows an overlapping area of the model called the View Cube. Your current layout can be saved as a template, which means that you can quickly reuse this layout on other drawings. In version 2016, you can create a blueprint. The export function allows you to save drawings or plans to different formats. The functionality of the 3D option of AutoCAD allows you to create architectural model. AutoCAD 2012 is available in two versions: AutoCAD LT for desktop systems, and AutoCAD LT for Windows Embedded Standard. Drafting and drawing are not the only AutoCAD function available. You can also use the application to create presentation-ready designs. 3D Modeling, editing and rendering. If you have to create architectural models for your project, then you will require a version of AutoCAD that can create architectural 3D models.
